Reception Application September 2018 Appointments are now available for Fr Nicholas to sign the Certificate of Catholic Practice for your child's reception application. Interviews take place on Tuesday 21st November (4pm-6pm) and 28th November (5pm-7pm). Please put your name down on the sheet at the back. In order for Fr Nicholas to sign the CCP you need to demonstrate that you are a practicing Catholic, which means (in terms of school applications) coming to Mass on Sundays. The easiest way to demonstrate this is by showing at least six months of signatures on our Mass Attendance Cards. If you have not been attending Mass regularly in recent months then Fr Nicholas cannot sign the CCP, even if you are known to him. Nursery forms will be signed in January.

Parish Census We are updating the details of parishioners that we keep in the parish office. This is purely for internal use, allowing us to reach you in case of an emergency or if you ask us to contact you (answer phone messages are sometimes unclear). At the back of the sheet you can indicate if you would like to get more involved in the life of the parish. Please pick up a census sheet from the back of the church (one per family) and return to Fr Nicholas/Angela or put them through the presbytery door. We ask that everyone who regularly attends our church completes one, even if you are well known to us or have previously completed a census form! Thank you.
