**This week** we will be making another trip to the battlefields of World War One with a small group of parishioners, focussing on the Belgian city of Mons and stopping off also at Waterloo. Consequently there will be **no Masses Tuesday to Thursday**. Please also note that, due to the bank Holiday, **Mass on Monday will be at the later time of 10am**.

**New Mass Attendance Cards** All those who currently have a Mass Attendance Card signed should collect a new one today from Angela or Fr Nicholas.

**Next Sunday's 10.30am Mass** is the First Communion Thanksgiving Mass, at the end of which there will be a procession of the Blessed Sacrament. There will be a children's party afterwards, organised by the parents, and no teas and coffees.

**Day Pilgrimage to Wells** takes place on Saturday 14th July. This delightful Somerset city boasts a medieval cathedral and moated bishop's palace. We will be celebrating Mass at the Catholic church of SS Joseph and Teresa and attending Evensong at the cathedral. The cost is £20 per person, including coach travel. We will be departing around 8.30am and return to Uxbridge in the evening. Please see Angela or Fr Nicholas with your money to secure a place.

**Bible Timeline** is not taking place this Sunday due to the Bank Holiday weekend. We will conclude St Luke's Gospel (chapter 19 to end) at the following session which will be on Sunday 3rd June 6pm-7.30pm in the Church Hall.

**First Friday Mass in June** Our monthly Traditional Sung Latin Mass will be celebrated on 8th June (Feast of the Sacred Heart) rather than 1st June at 7pm.

**Quiz Night** will be taking place on Saturday 2nd June at 7.30pm. All money raised will go to Mary's Meals. Tickets are £10, including fish n' chip supper, and are available this weekend after Mass.

**St Mary's School Summer Raffle** Over the coming few weeks St Mary's parents will be selling raffle tickets before and after weekend masses. This is part of their summer celebration leading up to the fete on Saturday 23rd June, 12noon - 3pm. Tickets are £1 each and prizes include £200 and £100 in cash and four day passes to EuroDisney Paris.

**First Communion 2019** If you would like your child to be enrolled in the First Holy Communion programme starting in September—and your child is therefore currently in Year 2 or above—please see Fr Nicholas or Angela after Sunday Mass as soon as possible.

**GDPR Compliance** As you know, the General Data Protection Regulation came into force on 25th May and this parish, like all other organisations, is affected. Our various application forms are being changed, we have updated Accident Books in the hall and sacristy, so that they have removable perforated pages, and all contact information has been removed from noticeboards in the porch, hall and sacristy. Our CCTV providers will be updating signage. If you are a volunteer and have not yet returned your confidentiality agreement, then please do so asap. Those who use computers for parish work need to sign a Computer User Agreement.

**Adoremus – National Eucharistic Congress** The largest gathering of Catholics in England since the 2010 Papal Visit takes place in Liverpool this September. You are invited to Liverpool on **Saturday, 8** and/or **Sunday, 9 September**. Saturday, in the Echo Arena, is the highlight of the Congress. Bishop Robert Barron, known to millions on social Media, will address the Congress; Cardinal Nichols will give a reflection and lead us in Adoration and Benediction. (There is a fee of £40 for the Saturday to cover the costs of the Congress.) On the Sunday there are Masses in the Metropolitan Cathedral and a large outdoor Blessed Sacrament procession.
