Sunday Parking Please remember to avoid blocking the BT gates (which are in use 24/7) or parking near the roundabout (alongside the railings). Please also park sensibly in front of the presbytery—there should be space for 6-8 cars here but poor parking can limit capacity and make life difficult for other church users.

We try to be as accessible as possible as a parish team. However, we have recently had some people send us messages, expecting an immediate reply within a few hours. Please remember that

we receive a large number of messages every day, and that we are not always at our desks due to pastoral visits, school Masses, meetings, etc. We are also closed on Thursdays and outside of normal working hours. We aim to recalls, WhatsApp messages, etc within 3 working days.

Mass Attendance Cards If your child needs a priest's reference (CCP) for a school application over the next year please make sure you are engaging regularly in the life of the parish. We now expect families to be physically attending Mass and Fr Nicholas or Angela sign cards at the end of weekend Masses. Please note that CCPs only need to be signed in the year of application since they expire after 6-12 months.

Looking Ahead We are planning a Day of Recollection at Pield Heath School (open to all the Deanery) on Saturday on Saturday 23rd March, led by the Bible scholar, Fr John Hemer MHM, helping us get ready for Holy Week. Our Day Pilgrimage will be to the cathedral city of Chichester (West Sussex) and will take place

on Saturday 29th June. As a whole, the Church is getting ready for the **Jubilee** or Holy Year of 2025. Pope Francis has requested that 'we devote 2024, the year preceding the Jubilee event, to a great "symphony" of prayer. Prayer, above all else, to renew our desire to be in the presence of the Lord, to listen to him and to adore him.' Watch this space for further details!
