Sanctuary Lamps burn this week for Holy Souls (Blessed Sacrament) and First Communion children (Our Lady). **This weekend** the Good Shepherd Company, which is based in Nottingham, will be offering olive wood carvings made in Bethlehem for sale. This supports Christian families in the Holy Land, preventing them from leaving in search of better work opportunities. Only 41,000 Christians now remain in the area.

First Holy Communion Mass The final celebration takes place at 10am and 2pm on Saturday 18th May. There will be no confessions/adoration that day, and the 5pm Vigil Mass takes place as usual. Let us pray for our 53 children and their families! The Thanksgiving Mass will be on Saturday 1st June at 2pm.

The Government are planning to lift the faith-based admissions cap on new free schools, subject to a public consultation. This would


