Please note there are no Masses this Monday and Tuesday; otherwise Mass times are as usual.

First Holy Communion 2025 If your child will be in Year 3 or above from September 2024 and if you live within our parish boundaries and/or regularly attend our church, then we invite you to consider applying to make their First Holy Communion next year. Forms will be available from July and need to be completed and brought in at enrolment appointments on 21st-22nd September 2024. We also ask you to make sure your Mass Attendance Card is being signed regularly (please collect one from us ASAP). The programme for parents begins in September 2024, in person, and for children, in person in the parish hall, from October. The children's sessions are on Saturday afternoons at 3.30-4.45pm. The children are then encouraged to join the Saturday 5pm Mass. There are 10 children's sessions in total and 3 parents' sessions. The First Holy Communion Masses will be in May/June 2025 (dates to be confirmed).

Day Pilgrimage to Chichester on Saturday 29th June—bookings are now open, £25pp, travel to and from Chichester by coach from our church. Once paid we will add you to the list. There will be a 8.15am Mass that morning in the church, in which we will be celebrating St Richard of Chichester, followed by departure at 9am to Sussex. We will have a tour of the cathedral, free time to explore the city, and then attend Evensong at the cathedral before returning to Uxbridge (arrival at approx. 8pm).

Mary's Meals would like to thank everyone in the parish for their wonderful generosity in response to our Foreign Currency initiative.
