Sanctuary Lamps burn this week for Eoin Martins, int (Blessed Sacrament) and First Communion children (Our Lady). Visit of the Mitten of Padre Pio to our church takes place this Saturday (4th May); it will be present at the 10am Mass and afterwards there will be a talk and devotions, taking the place of our usual confessions/adoration (confessions will instead be available 4.15-4.45pm).

Ascension Day is on Thursday 9th May; it is a Holyday of Obligation and there will be Masses in the church at 9.30am and 7pm. Please note that earlier that week there will be no **Mass on Bank Holiday Monday (6th May) or Tuesday 7th.** There is no Ignatian Prayer Group on Tuesday.

First Holy Communion Masses take place at 10am and 2pm on Saturdays 11th and 18th May. There will be no confessions/adoration on those days, and the 5pm Vigil Mass takes place as usual. Let us pray for our 52 children and their families!
